

Portfolio Information

A portfolio is a planned collection of documentation about a child. It should be comprehensive in nature, which means it should show all areas of development and can take various physical forms, depending on the preferences of the provider.

Assessment is the process of finding out what children can do, what they know, and what they are interested in.

Required components:

1. **Developmental Checklist** for referencing child's accomplishments
2. **Dated documentation** representing each developmental domain*
Documentation may include (but is not limited to):
Observational Notes - written by the teacher or parent
Pictures of the child**
Child's Work Samples**

* All documentation must be accompanied by date

** Must be accompanied with a brief description of developmental relevance
